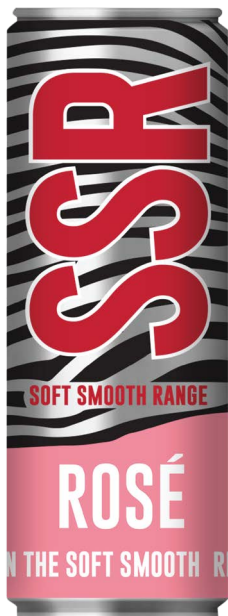
BACKGROUND
